Compiler Instructions

Thank-you for being a Compiler! Please review these instructions and keep them for reference.

- If you need to change your schedule, please call Rich Conroy (215-480-9116) if you know in advance. Call Rich, Andy Fayer (215-205-8670) or Jamie Stewart (215-280-6509) if your need is immediate.
- Fill in the weather and observation codes at the **end** of each hour. **Failure to do so will result in cruel and inhuman public humiliation.** The barometric pressure will be obtained online from the National Weather Service, the rest is up to you. Please enter cloud cover in 10% increments. Use the Remote reading for temperature and humidity.
- The thermometer is hidden under the bottom step of the tower stairs. Please return it to that location at the end of the day.
- **Please check your figures and be sure to fill in all data** at the conclusion of the last hour.
- **Please DO NOT take your field sheets home!** Morning compilers can leave their field sheets on the bulletin board, with Andy or with the afternoon compiler. Remember to put your numbers on the board. Afternoon compilers, please put your numbers on the bulletin board, including the total for the day and year. Then put your field sheet in the folder provided on the bulletin board.
- **All sheets must be left in folder on the bulletin board at the end of the day. If your sheet is missing, the count for the day will not be submitted to HMANA.**
- The bulletin board will be secured with padlocks which can be opened with the following combination:

Turn Right (clockwise) 3 times past [REDACTED] and stop at [REDACTED]
Turn Left (counter-clockwise) past [REDACTED] and stop at [REDACTED]
Turn Right (clockwise) and stop at [REDACTED]
Pull shackle
